Quilt Design Gary Darwin Finished Size 44" x 52"

Materials

Yardage based on 42" wide fabric

1 ¼ yd. of 1305 (safari stripe)
½ yd. of HDK(green kona)
¼ yd. of 31005-2 (red geometric)
¾ yd. of (solid black)
¾ yd. of 1300 (black background)
½ yd. of 1302 (monkey print)
¼ yd. of HDK(gold kona)
½ yd. of 1301 (elephant print)
½ yd. of 1303 (Mountain scene)
½ yd. of 1304 (giraffe Print)
4 yd. of backing of your choice
HDK = (hand dyed kona)

Cutting

From 1305 cut:

Three 4 ½" x length of the fabric; crosscut into three 4 ½" x 38 ½" rectangles

From Green hand dyed kona cut:

Seven 1 ½" x 42" strips; crosscut into six 1 ½" x 38" rectangles and two 1 ½" x 14 ½" rectangles

From 31005-2 cut:

Three 1 ½" x 42" strips

From 1300 cut:

Three 6 ½" x 42" Strips

From 1302 cut:

Three 4 ½" x 42" strips; crosscut into three 4 ½" x 16 ½" and three 4 ½" x 7 ½"

From gold hand dyed kona cut:

Two 1 ½" x 42" Strips

From 1301 cut:

One 14 ½" x 42" strip; crosscut center the elephant 14 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle

From 1303 cut:

One 14 ½" x 42" strip; crosscut 14 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle

From 1304 cut:

One 14 ½" x 42" strip; crosscut to center the giraffe 14 ½" x 12 ½" rectangle

Directions

1. With right sides together, sew a 1 ½" x 42" gold strip and a 4 ½" x 42" solid black strip together to form a strip set and press. Repeat to make two strip sets. Cut these strip sets into nine 4 ½" sections.

2. Referring to the photo on the front for placement, sew a section from step 1 to each end of a ½" x 7 ½" monkey print rectangle and press.

3. Referring to the photo sew the remaining sections from step 1 to one end of a 4 ½" x 16 ½" rectangle and press.

4. Referring to the photo for placement, sew a section from step 2 and 3 together to make one long strip. Repeat to make a total of three strips.

5. Sew 1 ½" x 38 ½" strip to each side of the strips completed in step 4 and press.

6. Referring to the diagram and placement of the 14 ½" x 12 ½" rectangles. (1301 bottom rectangle / 1303 center rectangle / 1304 top rectangle) . Sew a 1 ½" x 14 ½" Green HDK to the top of the rectangle that is to be on the bottom. Sew together 1 ½" x 14 ½" Green kona strip to the top of the middle rectangle and press. Sew the bottom and middle sections together and press. Then add the top rectangle and press.

7. Sew the 4 ½" x 38 ½" strip print and the strips completed in step 5 and 6 together and press.

8. Sew the 1 ½" x 42" red geometric strips together end to end to create one long strip. Cut this strip into two 1 ½" x 52 ½" sections. Sew each of these sections to the top and bottom of the top you created in step 7 and press.

9. Repeat step 8 using the 6 ½" x 42" black background print.

10. Layer the quilt top batting and backing together and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
