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## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 Panel (Y0630-31M)
- ½ yd Lt. Blue Sun/Moon (Y0631-29M)
- 1 yd Dk. Blue Moon (Y0632-31M)
- ¾ yd Aqua Main Print (Y0633-30M)
- ½ yd Red Tonal (90333-3M)
- 1¼ yd Purple Tonal (90333-8M)
- ½ yd Orange Tonal (90333-10M)
- ⅞ yd Blue Tonal (90333-2M)
- ⅜ yd Pink Tonal (90333-5M)
- 1¼ yd Turquoise Tonal (90333-6M)
- 4 yd Backing of your choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Panel fussy cut:

8 - 6½" squares of panel images

### From the Lt. Blue Sun/Moon cut:

8 - 3½" x 6½" rectangles

8 - 3½" squares

4 - 2½" x 12½" rectangles

### From the Dk. Blue Moon cut:

8 - 2½" x WOF

2 - 2½" x 28½" rectangles

2 - 2½" x 16½" rectangles

6 - 2½" x 12½" rectangles

### From the Aqua Main Print cut:

2 - 12½" x 16½" rectangles

2 - 12½" squares

### From the Red Tonal cut:

2 - 2½" x WOF

16 - 3½" squares

### From the Purple Tonal cut:

7 - 4½" x WOF

8 - 3½" x squares

### From the Orange Tonal cut:

2 - 2½" x WOF

16 - 3½" squares

### From the Blue Tonal cut:

24 - 3½" x 6½" rectangles

24 - 3½" squares

### From the Pink Tonal cut:

2 - 2½" x WOF

8 - 3½" squares

### From the Turquoise Tonal cut:

9 - 2½" x WOF (7 are for binding)

16 - 3½" squares

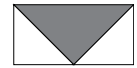
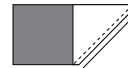
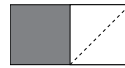

### Star Block - Finished Size: 12" x 12"

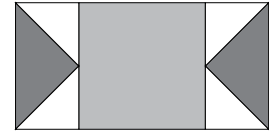
1. With a pencil, draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the 3½" Pink Tonal squares.



Place one of these squares on the end of a 3½" x 6½" Blue Tonal rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance to within ¼" of the seam and press open. Repeat on the other corner as shown. Repeat to make a total of four.



2. Watching placement, sew two units from step 1 to the right and left sides of a 6½" panel image square, press toward the square.
3. Sew a 3½" Blue Tonal square to the right and left sides of the remaining two units from step 1, press out. Sew these units to the top and bottom of the unit from step 2, press.



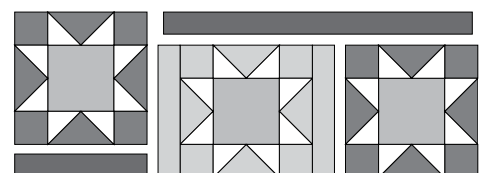
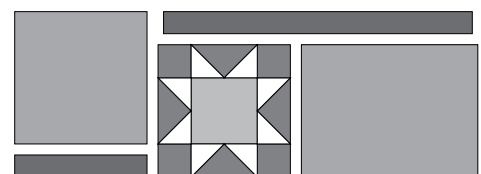
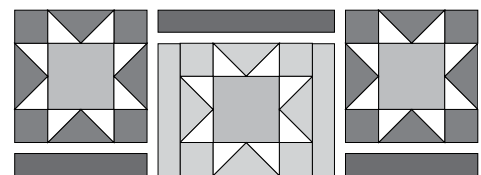
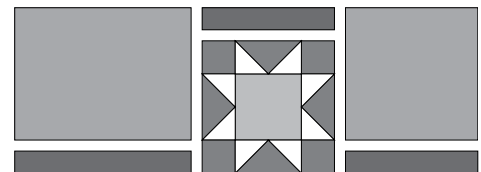
4. Repeat these steps to make one Red, two Orange and two Turquoise stars. With each of these stars the Pink Tonal squares will be replaced by Red, Orange or Turquoise Tonal squares and the Blue Tonal pieces will remain the same.
5. Repeat the steps again to make one Purple and one Red star this time replacing the Blue Tonal squares and rectangles with the Lt. Blue Sun/Moon squares and rectangles. Sew a 2½" x 12½" Lt. Blue Sun/Moon rectangle to the right and left sides of these stars, press.

### Checkerboard

1. Create a strip set by sewing a 2½" x WOF Pink Tonal to a 2½" x WOF Dk. Blue Moon, press. Repeat to make two strip sets. Cut this strip set into twenty-seven 2½" sections.
2. Repeat step 1 replacing the Pink Tonal with a Red Tonal and cut into twenty-one 2½" sections. Repeat again this time using the Orange Tonal in place of the Pink and cut into thirty-two 2½" sections. Repeat one last time using the Turquoise Tonal instead of the Pink and cut into twenty-four 2½" sections.
3. Using the sections from step 2, sew twenty-eight sections together to create a checkerboard strip for the right side of the quilt top. Refer to the quilt image for color placement. Repeat for the left side of the quilt. Sew twenty-four sections together for the top and bottom.

### Putting It Together

1. Referring to the diagram and quilt image, arrange the star blocks and Aqua Main Print squares and rectangles into rows. Add the Dk. Blue Moon rectangles to the top or bottom of the units in each row as shown. Sew the units together into rows and press; then sew the rows together.
2. Sew the longer checkerboard strips to the right and left sides of the quilt top and press. Then sew the shorter checkerboard strips to the top and bottom and press.
3. Sew the 1½" x WOF Turquoise Tonal strips together end to end to make one long strip, press. Sew this strip to the right side of the quilt top, press and trim excess. Repeat on the left, top and bottom of the quilt top.
4. Repeat step three using the 4½" x WOF Purple Tonal strips.
5. Layer quilt top, batting and backing and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.
