Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 - Fanciful Felines Panel (90340-1M)
- 5/8 Yard - Cats with Flowers (90341-1M)
- 1/4 Yard - Aqua SmallCats (90344-4M)
- 1/4 Yard - Yellow Small Cats (90344-6M)
- 1/4 Yard - Pink Flowers (90347-5)
- 1/4 Yard - Green Flowers (90347-8)
- 3/4 Yard - Basics: Black Multi-colors (90332-1)
- 1/2 Yard - Binding: Black squares (90345-1)
- 1 1/2 Yards - Backing of your choice
- Suggested: Aqua Large Cats (90343-4M)

Directions

Assemble the Panel Center

1. Trim the Fanciful Felines panel to approximately 21 1/2" x 23 1/2".
Note: Because the panel measurement may vary, the next step in the instructions will add a larger border that will be trimmed to the necessary finished size.
2. Sew a 3 1/2" x 26 1/2" Black Multi-colors squares strip to each long edge of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip (Fig. 1).

3. Sew a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" Black Multi-colors squares strip to the top and bottom edges of the panel; press away from the panel. Trim the excess fabric from each edge of the black border strip.
4. Trim the panel, with borders added, to measure 24 1/2" x 28 1/2".

Add the Borders

1. Referring to the quilt photo for color placement, sew together fourteen 2 1/2" squares using a combination of Aqua Small Cats squares, Yellow Small Cats squares, Pink Flowers squares and Green Flowers squares to make a side border unit (Fig. 2). The finished border strip should measure 2 1/2" x 28 1/2", including seam allowances. Repeat to make a total of four border units.

2. Sew a border unit to each long edge of the panel center; press toward the border unit. Sew the remaining two border units to the top and bottom of the panel center; press toward the border unit.
3. Sew a 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" Black Multi-colors squares strip to the long edges of the quilt center; press toward the black. Sew a 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" Cats with Flowers border strip to each black border strip; press toward the cats.
4. Sew a 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" Black Multi-colors squares strip to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center; press toward the black.
5. Sew a 2 1/2" Aqua Small Cats square, a 2 1/2" Green Flowers square, a 2 1/2" Pink Flowers square and a 2 1/2" Yellow Small Cats square together into a four-patch unit (Fig. 3).
6. Join two four-patch units, two 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" Black Multi-colors squares rectangles and a 4 1/2" x 28 1/2" Cats with Flowers border strip together (Fig. 4) to make a border unit. Repeat to make a total of two outer border units.

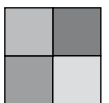

7. Sew a border unit to the top and bottom edges of the quilt center; press towards the outer border.

Cut the Fabrics

From the Cats with Flowers cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" border strips
- 2 - 4 1/2" x 28 1/2" border strips

From the Aqua Small Cats cut:

- 18 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Yellow Small Cats cut:

- 18 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Pink Flowers cut:

- 18 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Green Flowers cut:

- 18 - 2 1/2" squares

From the Black Multi-colors squares cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips
- 2 - 3 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 38 1/2" strips
- 2 - 1 1/2" x 32 1/2" strips
- 4 - 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
