## Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 3/4 Yard - Blocks (Y0068-1)
- 1-1/3 Yards - Dessert Stripe (Y0069-1)
- 3/4 Yards - Brown Chips (Y0074-4), includes binding
- 1-1/4 Yards - Off-White Tossed Desserts (Y0072-1)
- 3-3/4 Yards - Backing fabric of choice, suggested Pink Strawberries (Y0073-2)

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric

LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Blocks cut:

- 1 - 24-1/2" square

### From the Dessert Stripe cut:

- 4 - 9" x WOF strips, refer to the photo to fussy-cut

### From the Brown Chips cut:

- 2 - 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" strips from the WOF
- 2 - 1-1/2" x WOF strips, Cut into two 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips.  
*Note: If fabric is NOT sufficiently wide enough to cut strips 43-1/2" long, then cut three 1-1/2" x WOF strips and piece to make two strips 1-1/2" x 43 1/2".*
- 6 - 2-1/4" x WOF strips for Binding

### From the Tossed Desserts cut:

- 5 - 6-1/2" x WOF strips, Piece into two 6-1/2" x 55-1/2" strips and two 6-1/2" x 43-1/2" strips.

### From the Pink Strawberries cut:

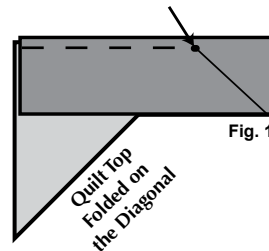
- Cut and sew together one 63" square for the backing.

### Quilt Top Assembly Instructions:

- 1) Center one 9" x WOF Dessert Stripe on one side of the quilt top. Make sure the bottom edge of the stripe lines up with the quilt center. Start sewing the strip 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop 1/4" from the bottom edge. Back tack at the start and end of each seam. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.**
- 2) Repeat with the remaining three Dessert Stripes, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top.
- 3) To miter each corner, fold the quilt top on a diagonal, back sides together. **This should line up the strips from adjacent sides** (Fig. 1).



- 4) Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.
- 5) Sew one 1-1/2" x 41-1/2" Brown Chip strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 1-1/2" x 43-1/2" Brown Chip strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 6) Sew one 6-1/2" x 43-1/2" Tossed Desserts strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 6-1/2" x 55-1/2" Tossed desserts strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 7) Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
