Materials

yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- Fabric A - 1 1/2 yards of SKU 24001-1
- Fabric B - 1/4 yard of SKU 24001-2
- Fabric C - 1/4 yard of SKU 24002-1
- Fabric D - 1/4 yard of SKU 24005-3
- Fabric E - 1/4 yard of SKU 24010-1
- Fabric F - 1/4 yard of SKU 24010-2
- Fabric G - 1/2 yard of SKU 24010-3
- Fabric H - 1/4 yard of SKU 24011-2
- Fabric I - 1/2 yard of SKU 24011-4
- Fabric J - 1/2 yard of SKU 24012-2
- Fabric K - 1/4 yard of SKU 24012-4
- Binding - 1/2 yard of SKU 24010-2
- Backing - 4 1/4 yards (your choice)

Cut the Fabrics

Fabric A

- 12 - 5 3/8" squares
- 6 - 6 1/2" x Width of Fabric strips pieced together to make:
 - 2 - 6 1/2" x 55 1/2" borders
 - 2 - 6 1/2" x 56 1/2" borders

Fabric B

- 24 - 2 1/2" squares

Fabric C

- 6 - 6 1/2" squares

Fabric D

- 24 - 2 1/2" squares

Fabric E

- 12 - 3 7/8" squares

Fabric F

- 6 - 5 3/8" squares

Fabric G

- 24 - 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles

Fabric H

- 6 - 5 3/8" squares

Fabric I

- 5 - 2 1/2" x Width of Fabric strips pieced together to make:
 - 2 - 2 1/2" x 43 1/2" border strips
 - 2 - 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" border strips

Fabric J

- 24 - 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles

Fabric K

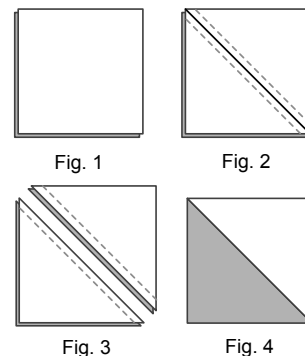
- 12 - 3 7/8" squares
- 6 - 3 1/2" squares

Directions

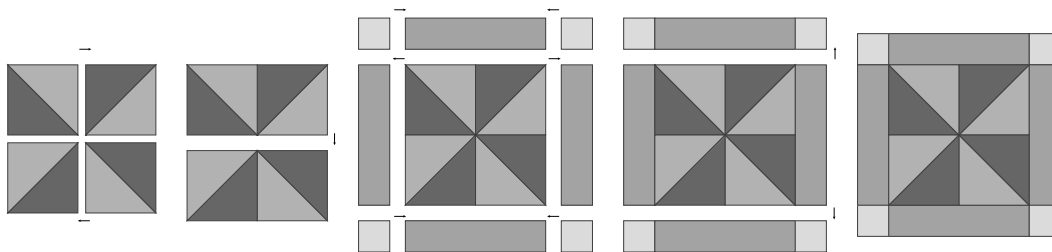
Half-Square Triangle Units

1. Place one 5 3/8" Fabric H square on top of one 5 3/8" Fabric A square, right sides together. (Fig. 1) Draw a diagonal line through the center of either block. Sew 1/4" away from each side of the diagonal line. (Fig 2)
2. Cut the square on the drawn line to make two half-square triangle units. (Fig. 3) Open each half-square triangle unit and press towards the dark. (Fig. 4)
3. Repeat this process to make the following half-square triangle units: twelve H/A, twelve F/A and twenty-four K/E.



Pinwheel Blocks - Finished Block Size: 13" square

1. Layout two H/A half-square triangle units, two F/A half-square triangle units, four 2 1/2" Fabric B squares and four 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric G rectangles. (See Pinwheel Block Assembly Diagram)

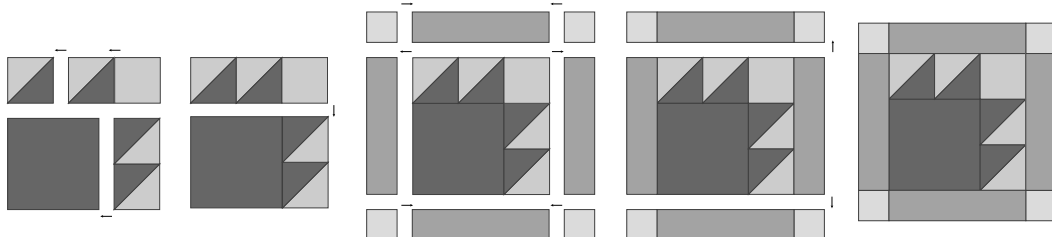


Pinwheel Block Assembly Diagram

2. Sew together the pieces in each row, pressing the seam allowances in opposite directions for each row. Join the rows together to complete the block. Repeat this process to make a total of six Pinwheel Blocks

Bear Paw Blocks - Finished Block Size: 13" square

1. Layout four K/E half-square triangle units, one 3 1/2" Fabric K square, one 6 1/2" Fabric C square, four 2 1/2" Fabric D squares and four 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric J rectangles. (See Bear Paw Block Assembly Diagram)
2. Sew together the pieces in each row, pressing the seam allowances in opposite directions for

each row. Join the rows together to complete the block.

3. Repeat this process to make a total of six Bear Paw Blocks

Assemble The Quilt

1. Following the quilt photo for the quilt top layout, sew the 12 blocks into four rows of three blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the quilt center.
2. Sew one Fabric I border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the remaining two Fabric I border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.
3. Sew one Fabric A border strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew the remaining two Fabric A border strips to the top and bottom of the quilt center to complete the quilt top.
4. Layer, quilt and bind as desired.
