## Materials

*Yardages based on 42" wide fabric. The instructions are written for the blue quilt. If you prefer to make the green please use the instructions in parenthesis.*

- 3/4 Yard or length of one Panel 29010-1 (same)
- 1 Yard - Blue Toss 29011-1 (29011-3)
- 1/3 Yard - Stripe 29012-1 (same)
- 1/2 Yard - Blue Floral 29013-1 (29013-4)
- 3/4 Yard - Green Floral 29013-3 (29013-2)
- 1/2 Yard - Blue Pindot 29014-1 (29014-2)
- 1 Yard - Green Pindot 29014-3 (29014-4)
- 1/3 Yard - Brown Pindot 29014-5 (same)
- 5/8 Yard - White Pindot 29014-6 (29014-3)
- 3 Yards backing of your choice

## Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric  
LOF = Length of Fabric

### From the Panel fussy cut:

- 4 – 7" wide x 8" tall rectangles

### From the Blue Toss (Green Toss) cut:

- 5 – 5½" x WOF strips

### From the Stripe (same) fussy cut:

- 5 – 8" squares

### From the Blue Floral (Gold Floral) cut:

- 18 – 4½" squares

### From the Green Floral (Cream Floral) cut:

- 144 – 2½" squares

### From the Blue (Cream) Pindot cut:

- 10 – 2½" x 8" rectangles
- 10 – 2½" x 12" rectangles

### From the Green (Gold) Pindot cut:

- 8 – 3" x 8" rectangles
- 8 – 2½" x 12" rectangles
- 5 – 2½" x WOF (binding)

### From the Brown (same) Pindot cut:

- 5 – 1½" x WOF

### From the White (Green) Pindot cut:

- 2 – 1½" x 30½" strips
- 2 – 1½" x 32½" strips
- 18 – 4½" squares

## Directions

### Blocks: 10½" x 10½"

1. Sew a 3" x 8" Green (Gold) Pindot to each side of the 7" x 8" Panel rectangles and press. Sew the remaining Green (Gold) Pindot rectangles to the top and bottom and press.
2. Sew the 2½" x 8" Blue (Cream) Pindot to each side of the 8" stripe squares and press. Sew the remaining Blue (Cream) Pindot rectangles to the top and bottom and press.
3. Using the blocks completed in step 1 and an erasable fabric pen, draw a 10½" square at a slight angle. Trim away the excess fabric. Diagram 1
4. Repeat step 3 using the blocks completed in step 2, tilting the blocks in the opposite direction.

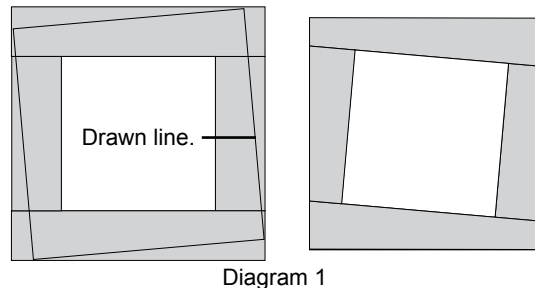

### Putting it Together

1. Referring to the color diagram sew the completed blocks from step 3 and 4 above into rows and sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.
2. Sew the 1½" x 30½" White (Green) Pindot strips to each side of the quilt top and press. Sew the remaining two White (Green) Pindot strips to the top and bottom and press.
3. Place a 2½" Green (Cream) Floral Square on the corner of a 4½" Blue (Gold) Floral square and sew across the Green (Cream) Floral Square diagonally. Trim to within ¼" of the seam and press outward. Repeat on the remaining three corners of the Blue (Gold) Floral squares. Make a total of eighteen. Diagram 2
4. Repeat step three using the White (Green) Pindot squares and the remaining 2½" Green (Cream) Floral squares. Repeat to make a total of eighteen.
5. Referring to the color diagram, sew together four blocks from step three and four blocks from step four alternating each block. Sew this strip to the side of the quilt and press. Repeat for the other side.
6. Repeat step five using a total of 5 blocks from step three and five blocks from step four. Sew this strip to the top of the quilt. Repeat for the bottom.
7. Sew the 1½" x WOF Brown Pindot strips together end to end to make one long strip. From this strip cut two 1½" x 40½" strips and two 1½" x 42½" strips.
8. Sew the 1½" x 40½" Brown Pindot strips to each side of the quilt top and press. Sew the remaining two Brown Pindot strips to the top and bottom of the quilt and press.
9. Sew the 5½" x WOF Blue Toss (Green Toss) strips together end to end to make one long strip. From this strip cut two 5½" x 42½" strips and two 5½" x 52½" strips.
10. Sew the 5½" x 42½" strips to each side of the quilt top and press. Sew the remaining two Blue (Green) Toss strips to the top and bottom of the quilt top and press.
11. Layer quilt top, batting, and backing together and quilt as desired. Add binding to the quilt.

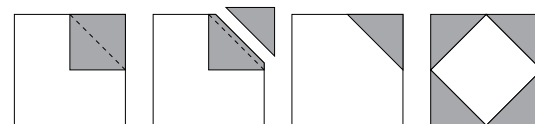
