Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1 Panel - Newton Sheep (29000-1)
- 1 7/8 Yards - Newton Stripe (29002-1)
- 1/4 Yard - Yellow & Green Dot (29003-2)
- 3/8 Yard - Yellow Hearts (29004-2)
- 1/4 Yard - White Hearts (29004-6)
- 1/2 Yard - Blue Diamonds (29005-3)
- 3/8 Yard - Purple Diamonds (29005-1)
- 3 1/2 Yards - Backing of your choice
- Suggested: Aqua Newtons (29001-3)
- 1 - 56" x 70" piece of batting

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Newton Sheep Panel cut:

- Fussy cut 8 - 6 1/2" squares

From the Yellow & Green Dot cut:

- 3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

From the Yellow Hearts cut:

- 2 - 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" strips
- 2 - 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" strips

From the White Hearts cut:

- 3 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips

From the Blue Diamonds cut:

- 20 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" strips
- 6 - 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" strips

From the Newton Stripe cut:

- Fussy cut 2 - 10 1/4" x 63" strips from the LOF
- Fussy cut 2 - 10 1/4" x 49" strips from the LOF

From the Purple Diamonds cut:

- 5 - 2-1/4" x WOF for Binding

Directions

1. Place one 2 1/2" x WOF Yellow & Green Dot strips, right side together with one 2 1/2" x WOF white hearts strip. Sew them together lengthwise. Press towards the yellow fabric.
2. Sew another 2 1/2" x WOF Yellow & Green Dots strip to the other side of the White Hearts strip (fig. 1) to make one Strip Set A. Press towards the yellow fabric.
3. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 with two 2 1/2" x WOF White Hearts strips and one 2 1/2" x WOF Yellow & Green Dots strip (fig. 2) to make one Strip Set B

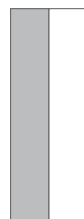

4. Cut fourteen 2 1/2" segments from Strip Set A (fig. 3).
5. Cut seven 2 1/2" segments from Strip Set B.
6. Sew one 2 1/2" Strip Set A segment to the top and bottom of one 2 1/2" Strip Set B segment to make one 6 1/2" checkerboard block. Repeat to make seven checkerboard blocks total.
7. Following the quilt photo, sew together three blocks, and four 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Blue Diamonds strips to make one row. Make four rows total.
8. Sew the rows together alternating with 1 1/2" x 22 1/2" Blue Diamonds strips to make the quilt top.
9. Sew one 2 1/2" x 36 1/2" Yellow Hearts strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew one 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" Yellow Hearts to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
10. Center one 10 1/2" x 63" Newton Stripe strip on each side of the quilt top. Start sewing the strip 1/4" from the top edge of the quilt top and stop 1/4" from the bottom edge.
11. Repeat with the two 10 1/2" x 49" Newton Stripe strips on the top and bottom of the quilt top, making sure to start and stop 1/4" away from each end of the quilt top.
12. To miter each corner, fold the quilt on a diagonal back sides together. This should line up the borders from the adjacent side (Fig. 4).
13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 4) draw a 45° line out to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

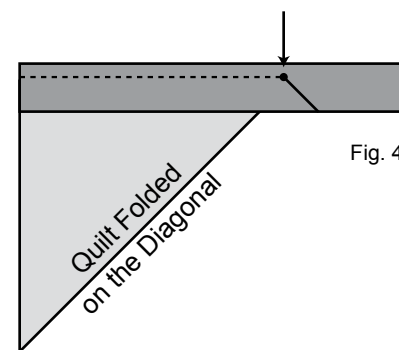

Finishing the Quilt

1. Layer the quilt top with the batting and backing. Baste the layers together.
2. Hand or machine quilt as desired. Square up the quilt sandwich.
3. Prepare the binding for the quilt by stitching the Purple Diamonds 2 1/2" strips end to end. Press the binding in half lengthwise, wrong sides together. Sew the binding to the quilt. Add a hanging sleeve, if desired, and a label.
