Materials

Yardages based on 42" wide fabric

- 1/2 Yard - Red Orchids (31011-01)
- 1 1/8 Yard - Light Blue Orchids (31011-4)
- 1/3 Yard - Blue Vines (31012-2)
- 1/2 Yard - Green Vines (31012-03)
- 1/4 Yard - Red Stones (31013-1)
- 1/4 Yard - Green Stones (31013-3)
- 1/4 Yard - Blue Stones (31013-4)
- 5/8 Yard - Blue Tonal (31014-2)
- 1/2 Yard - Binding Red Stripe (31015-1)
- 3 3/4 Yards - Backing of your choice
- Suggested - Blue Orchids (31011-2)

Cut the Fabrics

WOF = Width of Fabric
LOF = Length of Fabric

From the Red Orchids cut:

- 1 - 12 1/2" x WOF strip subcut into:
 - 5 - 12 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
- From the remainder of this strip cut:
 - 2 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Light Blue Orchids cut:

- 3 - 7 1/2" x LOF strips pieced into:
 - 2 - 7 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips
- 2 - 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips

From the Blue Vines cut:

- 2 - 4 1/2" x WOF strips subcut into:
 - 2 - 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles
 - 4 - 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Green Vines cut:

- 1 - 4 1/2" x WOF strip subcut into:
 - 2 - 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles
 - 2 - 4 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From the Red Stones cut:

- 4 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips subcut into:
 - 10 - 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles
 - 4 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From the Blue Stones cut:

- 3 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips subcut into:
 - 4 - 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles
 - 8 - 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

From the Green Stones cut:

- 2 - 1 1/2" x WOF strips subcut into:
 - 4 - 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" rectangles
 - 4 - 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles

From the Blue Tonal print cut:

- 5 - 2 1/2" x WOF strips pieced into:
 - 2 - 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips
 - 2 - 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" strips
- 2 - 3 1/2" x WOF strips subcut into:
 - 8 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles
 - 8 - 3 1/2" squares

Directions

Red Units

1. Sew a 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Red Stones rectangle to opposite edges of a 6 1/2" x 12 1/2" Red Orchids rectangle. Press the seams toward the Red Stones. Repeat to make a total of five large red units.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Red Stones Rectangle to opposite edges of a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Red Orchids Rectangle. Press the seams toward the Red Stones. Sew a 3 1/2" Blue Tonal square to each end of the Red Stones. Press the seams towards the Blue Tonal. Repeat to make a total of two small red units.

Blue Units

1. Sew a 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" Blue Stones rectangle to opposite edges of a 4 1/2" x 6 1/2" Blue Vines rectangle. Press the seams toward the Blue Stones. Sew a 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" Blue Tonal rectangle to the edge of the Blue Stones rectangles to make a small blue Unit. Press the seams toward the Blue Tonal. Repeat to make a total of four small blue units.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Blue Stones rectangle to opposite edges of a 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" Blue Vines rectangle to make a large blue unit. Press the seams toward the Blue Stones. Repeat to make a total of two large blue units.

Green Units

1. Sew a 1 1/2" x 3 1/2" Green Stones rectangle to opposite edges of a 3 1/2" x 4 1/2" Green Vine Rectangle. Press the seams toward the Green Stones. Sew a 3 1/2" Blue Tonal square to each Blue Stones rectangle to make a small green unit. Repeat to make a total of two small green units.
2. Sew a 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Green Stones rectangle to opposite edges of a 4 1/2" x 14 1/2" Green Vine Rectangle. Press the seams toward the Green Stones. Repeat to make a total of two large green units.

Assemble the Quilt

1. Following the assembly diagram, sew the units together in the order shown.
2. Sew a 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Blue Tonal strip to a 6 1/2" x 42 1/2" Light Blue Orchids strip to make a side border unit. Repeat to make a total of two side border units. Join the two side border units to each long edge of the quilt center.
3. Sew a 2 1/2" x 46 1/2" Blue Tonal strip to a 7 1/2" x 46 1/2" Light Blue Orchids strip to make a top border unit. Repeat to make a bottom border unit. Join these two border units to the top and bottom of the quilt center.
